FROM SYSTEM IMPROVEMENT TO COMMUNITY IMPACT

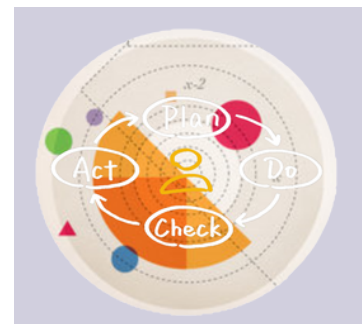
Purpose
